Welcome back! We have been very busy at the Community Resource Hub & Food Pantry. While we regularly receive food from our amazing county food bank *Replenish, Nourishing Neighbors* (formerly known as MCFOODS), there are some items that we are running low on. Aside from food, the students who visit the pantry are also very grateful to be able to pick up other living essentials: toiletries, cleaning products, back to school supplies, etc.

**Shelf stable food items currently needed:**

- Canned, dried, or jarred fruit, little fruit cups
- Juice, bottled water, seltzer
- Healthy snacks: granola/power/breakfast bars, Belvita Biscuits, crackers
- Boxes of breakfast cereal

**Non-Food Items in High Demand:**

- We ALWAYS need menstrual products (tampons and pads)
- Diapers (size 5 & 6 most needed), baby wipes
- Toiletries: Shampoo, Conditioner, Soap, Deodorant
- Any cleaning products: toilet paper, paper towels
- Toothpaste, mouthwash, toothbrushes
- BACK TO SCHOOL SUPPLIES!!!! Notebooks, pens, highlighters



**WHERE TO DONATE:**

1. Place items in **large contact free outdoor bin** at the back of the College Center beside the door closest to the Community Resource Hub & Food Pantry. This is off of College Drive East across from the Physical Education Center, between parking lots 16 and 3. Items can be placed in the bin at any time. The bin is checked daily for items. See picture above.
2. Place items in a **blue food pantry bins** located in the lobby of the College Center (outside the office of Student Life), at the Community Resource Hub & Food Pantry (College Center room 170/171), or in the lobbies of the Gateway Building and West Hall.
